3 Stolen Vehicles Recovered in NED, ED

North-Eastern Division conducted several anti-crime exercises between 1 pm to 11 pm which led to the recovery of several vehicles yesterday.

Police are following leads into the discovery of a white Toyota Fielder Wagon which was detected on Parris Boulevard, Laventille on November 27th. Barataria Criminal Investigations Department and officers from the Barataria Police Station received information that led them to the find.

In another exercise, officers of the Morvant Police Station responded to a report of Robbery with Aggravation which occurred yesterday. Acting on the information received, the officers made their way to Coconut Drive, in the vicinity of Malick Secondary School, where they canvassed the area which resulted in the recovery of one grey Hyundai Accent. The vehicle was taken to the station for processing and police are continuing leads into this recovery.
